



Notice of Filing of Application For Rezoning of a Local Historic District

Project: Judges Hill Local Historic District

Location: Generally between West 15th Street and West 18th Street; West Avenue and San Gabriel Street.

The City of Austin has sent this letter to inform you that we have received an application for the designation of the Judges Hill Local Historic District. We are notifying you because you live within the boundaries of the area being proposed for rezoning as a Local Historic District.

Local historic districts were created by the City Council as a tool to preserve the historic character of the city's older neighborhoods by introducing design standards for additions and changes to existing buildings and for new construction within the district. Designation of a neighborhood as a local historic district helps ensure that new construction within the district is compatible with the character of the area. Local historic district designation does not prohibit change or new construction, but rather sets design parameters based upon historical precedents while encouraging conservation and energy efficiency.

Local historic district designation includes a determination of contributing and non-contributing status for each property located in the district. Contributing properties are those that are at least 50 years old, were built during the period of significance of the district as defined in the application, and retain sufficient integrity of materials and design to convey their historic appearance. Evaluation of which buildings are contributing to the local historic district must be approved by the City's Historic Preservation Office.

The applicants for the Judges Hill Local Historic District have prepared a draft set of design standards, which are being reviewed by City staff. The City will host a meeting to seek your feedback on the proposed standards. Designation of the Hyde Park Local Historic District and the design standards for new construction activities within the district should be based upon the consensus of the residents of the district to the greatest extent possible. A separate notice will be mailed when a date and time has been determined for this public meeting, as well as the date and time for a public hearing with the Historic Landmark Commission.
